## ORGANICS IN SOUTH DAKOTA

Organic agriculture in South Dakota has seen notable growth in recent years, driven by increasing consumer demand for organic products, favorable government policies, and growing interest among farmers in sustainable practices. Organic farming in the state focuses on grains, oilseeds, legumes, hay, and livestock, supported by South Dakota's vast prairies and natural resources, which are conducive to organic farming systems.

Despite the progress, South Dakota's organic sector remains relatively small compared to neighboring states like Iowa, Montana, Nebraska, and North Dakota which dominate in organic production in terms of both the number of organic growers and the acreage of certified organic land. While South Dakota boasts substantial agricultural capacity, the percentage of organic growers and land in the state is still developing. According to USDA data\*, South Dakota has 120 certified operations. However, it continues to see growth as operators transition to organic systems and organizations like OCIA (Organic Crop Improvement Association) and TOPP (Transition to Organic Partnership Program) offer support for those making the shift.

The state's role in the national organic sector is poised to grow as more producers adopt regenerative practices, driven by economic and environmental incentives. While South Dakota may not yet be a leading state in organic farming, its potential remains significant, especially as more farmers become interested in sustainable land management and organic certification.


